

**ORLEANS PARISH SCHOOL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 36-15**

The following resolution was offered for adoption by Woody Koppel and seconded by Sarah Usdin:

A resolution setting forth and designating the adjusted millage rate and the increased millage rate on all the property subject to taxation in Orleans Parish, State of Louisiana.

WHEREAS, the Orleans Parish School Board (the “**School Board**”) noticed in the district’s Official Journal, *The Times-Picayune* on June 24, 2015 and on June 26, 2015 its intent to consider a millage roll forward and set the date for the public hearing on the proposed roll forward for November 17, 2015, at 4:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Orleans Parish School board held said public hearing at the Orleans Parish School Board Office, 3520 General DeGaulle Drive, Suite 4050, New Orleans, Louisiana 70114; and

WHEREAS, the La. Revised Statutes prescribe that when a taxing authority is rolling forward millage rates, the taxing authority is required to adopt two separate resolutions, one designates the adjusted millage rate, and the second designating the adjusted rate and the increased millage rate.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Orleans Parish School Board, State of Louisiana, in a public meeting held on November 17, 2015, which meeting was conducted in accordance with the Open Meetings Law and the additional requirements of Article VII, Section 23 (C) of Louisiana Constitution and R.S. 47:1705 (B), that the taxing district voted to increase the millage rate(s), but not in excess of the prior year’s maximum authorized rate(s), on all taxable property shown on the official assessment roll for the year 2016, when collected, the revenues from said taxes shall be used only for the specific purposes for which said taxes have been levied. Said millage rate(s) are:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Assessor of the Parish of Orleans shall extend upon the assessment roll for the year 2016 the taxes herein levied, and the tax collector of said Parish shall collect and remit the same to said taxing authority in accordance with law.

The foregoing resolution was read in full, the roll was called on the adoption thereof, and the resolution was adopted by no less than two-thirds of the total membership of the taxing authority voting in favor as required by Article VII, Section 23(C) of the Louisiana Constitution and R.S. 47:1705(B). 


